B. IRB is open for business for the summer: week after school is out we will send out an announcement that IRB is open for business for the summer, were there any PIs that missed the last deadline, Stark mentioned EdD program would like to begin collecting data with children this June or July, 3rd cohort coming through most will not be Full Board but perhaps one will be. This summer would be an exception due to COVID-19. We are growing by leaps and bounds. Stipends will need to be considered to compensate the members for work during the summer. Summer is a time to get things done for research. Stark will put some numbers together regarding budgets for IRB operations. Members are open to one Full Board meeting in the summer. RERC will draft an announcement for member review and edits. Olson mentioned how things will work when school is back in session regarding in-person research going forward. Stark mentioned perhaps an exception could be made for researchers. Wilson said if schools are letting kids back in, social distancing, talk to the districts about their protocols and protections. RERC mentioned it may depend on the type of interactions, put on the next agenda the information from our chancellor. Wilson mentioned we may not know until the last minute.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. Zenko Protocol, Repository Policy & Procedures: RERC gave overview of modification request for repository data and data banks, some IRBs have a form for PIs to fill out, have a question on the form re: repository and which data to be entered into the data bank, Livingston mentioned we are live for repository for thesis and dissertations allows for faculty to place their publications into the repository, almost ready here on the CSUB campus, new system is a new platform, a good thing for our campus, unites all 23 campuses, Livingston will send us a link, Wilson mentioned thesis is important, if we put the questions in the form, how do we check after the fact? Stark suggested using an example. Olson mentioned its great to be able to use this repository, should it be included in the informed consent form, concerns re: confidentiality and de-identified or identifiable data, the participants should be informed. Wilson said this is already being done, a lot of journals already require this. Livingston mentioned there was a student working with a sensitive nature, this was not entered into the repository, and many grants require data to be entered into a repository. Stark mentioned simply having a question there, RERC could assess the potential concerns, it is nice to have the explanations in the Cayuse IRB system, so the PI understands what it means and the regulations involved. As an IRB we could decide if this is something that needs to be included in the informed consent form. RERC may need to send to other members of the board for further review. There are checks and balances in place, the PI will tell us exactly which data will be involved and at that point an assessment is made as to the level of review is needed. Commuri asked for examples and templates. Williamson moved, Olson seconded

Stark, Wilson voiced concerns regarding setting a precedence , RERC clarified, the IRB is not stopping PI from collecting data. Commuri supports the motion to approve, all members raised their hands to approve Zenko's request
