**SUBJECT:** Annual California Whistleblower Protection Act Notification

The California Whistleblower Protection Act ("CWPA") (Government Code §§ 8547 et seq.) authorizes the Office of the California State Auditor to accept complaints from state employees and members of the public regarding alleged improper governmental activities by state agencies, departments, and employees. Improper acts by a state agency or employee that should be reported to the State Auditor include: violations of state or federal law; noncompliance with an executive order, a Rule of Conduct, the State Administrative Manual, or the State Contracting Manual; misuse or waste of state resources; and gross negligence, incompetence, or inefficiency. The CWPA also protects reporting parties from Retaliation.

In compliance with the CWPA, you will find the employee notification from the California State Auditor, with information on reporting improper activity, attached to this communication.
