

GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY (CY 2018- 19)

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Key Findings

- **Student Satisfaction**
 - More than half of all students indicated that they were ‘satisfied’ with their experience at CSUB
- **Time to Degree**
 - Undergraduate students were more likely to indicate that they graduated in ‘more time than expected’
 - Students were more likely to indicate that they had trouble getting classes
 - An ‘institutional schedule issue’ prevented students from getting classes
- **Skills and Knowledge**
 - On average students acquired a ‘somewhat’ amount of skills and knowledge through their students at CSUB
- **Class Activities**
 - Undergraduate and graduate students were equally likely to participate in an internship and/or community based learning
 - Just over a quarter of students did not participate in class activities
- **Post-Graduation Plans**
 - ‘Pursue/continue employment’ was the most prevalent response among students
- **Job Search**
 - Undergraduate students were more likely to indicate ‘looking but no offers yet,’ whereas graduate students were more likely to indicate ‘planning to stay in my current job after graduation’
 - More than three-fourths of all students who stayed in their current job or received an offer of employment indicated that their position was related to their field of study
 - Not many students used CSUB resources for their job search
- **Application Process**
 - Nearly three-fourths of undergraduate students indicated that they had ‘begun, but not finished the application process’ or ‘had not begun the application process’
 - Nearly half of the students were accepted to CSUB and expected to attend CSUB
 - Students indicated that their graduate program was related to their major
- **Highest Degree**
 - ‘Masters Degree’ was the most prevalent response among undergraduate students, whereas ‘Doctoral Degree’ was the most prevalent among graduate students
- **Library**
 - Students amount of time spent in the library or using the library resources online was fairly distributed between ‘less than one hour per week’ and ‘more than 5 hours per week’
- **Alumni Association**
 - Students were not familiar with alumni membership benefits
