After considerable effort on the part of the College Administration, Faculty, and Staff, the CSUB Liberal Studies Teacher Preparation Program is a Commission-Approved Elementary Subject Matter Preparation Program. Students who follow the current core requirements or curriculum of the Liberal Studies Teacher Preparation Program at CSUB may be eligible to utilize their coursework to meet the Elementary Subject Matter Competency requirement for Teacher Credentialing instead oftaking the Multiple Subjects CSETs. CSUB students who major in the Liberal Studies Teacher Preparation Program at CSUBand complete all required coursework will not need to provide CSET scores for Multiple Subjects or Education Specialist Credential Programs in the state of California starting August 2019. Individuals who do not have all the coursework required the Liberal Studies Teacher Preparation Program at CSUB will not qualify for Elementary Subject Matter competency proof through CSUB.

Students may demonstrate Elementary Subject Matter Competency by either providing successful CSET scores Multiple Subject, providing proof of Elementary Subject Matter Competency after having completed the appropriate coursework/program approved by the CTC with an overall ESM GPA of 2.67 (please note that an undergraduate GPA of 2.75 is required for admission to the CSUB Multiple Subject or Education Specialist Credential Programs.

At this point in time, Elementary Subject Matter evaluations will ONLY be completed for CURRENT STUDENTS or GRADUATES of a CSUB Liberal Studies Teacher Preparation Program *WHO BEGAN THEIR STUDIES IN FALL 2015 OR THEREAFTER*. A CSUB ID number is required for an evaluation to be conducted

- **Eligibility for ESM Waiver Proof:** Current students or graduates who have completed with a passing grade all required coursework or the equivalent of the Liberal StudiesTeacher Preparation Bachelor of Arts Program at CSUB with an overall ESM GPA of 2.67.
- Non-CSUB students at this point in time are not eligible to request an evaluation or receive proof of ESM subject matter competency through CSUB.

The request for an ESM waiver evaluation should be submitted at the beginning of your final semester of your B.A. or aftercompletion/graduation. Completion of the ESM waiver does not guarantee admission to the credential programs.

**Time Frame for ESM Waiver Evaluation**: Given the nature of analyzing and reviewing individual courses and the detailed academic course history of each individual application, allow 6-8 weeks for evaluation.
