



Due to a change in CSU Bakersfield's Chemistry requirement courses, effective 1/1/2024, CSUB Nursing will no longer be accepting an introductory chemistry course [CHEM 1010 or equivalent] for the Chemistry prerequisite requirement.

Beginning in Spring 2024, students looking to attend the Traditional BSN Program at CSUB, students must complete a chemistry course that is equivalent to [or higher than] CHEM 1000 or CHEM 1003.

For students who took a chemistry course equivalent to CHEM 1010 before Spring 2024, CSUB Nursing will still accept the course and the course will be replaced as CHEM 1003 for degree audit purposes. A list of CHEM 1010 or equivalent courses from transferrable college or universities are provided in the following page. If your college or university is not listed, check [ASSIST](#) for the course equivalency.

Chemistry FAQ's

Q: I took more than one Chemistry course. Which one will be considered?

When more than one Chemistry course was taken that meets the requirement, the second Chemistry grade will be used to meet the nursing prerequisite. Students who took an introductory chemistry course [CHEM 1010 or equivalent] and then took another chemistry course, the second Chemistry course grade will be used.

Q: Will taking more than one Chemistry course be counted as a prerequisite repeat?

Yes, multiple chemistry courses will count as a repeat. However, CHEM 1010 will not count as a repeat.

Q: I took more than one Chemistry course. Will the highest Chemistry grade be considered?

No, the second attempt Chemistry course will be used to meet the nursing prerequisite and will count as a repeat. If student failed their second Chemistry course, they will be considered ineligible for the program.

Q: I completed a Chemistry course with no lab. Will it be accepted?

Yes, it will be accepted for CSUB Nursing.

Q: Will an Introduction, Principles, or Fundamentals of Chemistry be accepted?

If the course is equivalent to CHEM 1010, it will not be accepted if the course was taken after Fall 2023. Starting in Spring 2024, the student will need CHEM 1000 or CHEM 1003 [or equivalent].
