COS students should complete the prerequisites, Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN), & CSU Transfer General Education requirements (101 semester units) at COS then apply and transfer to CSUB to begin the RN to BSN Program the next available term. All courses must be complete prior to beginning the RN to BSN Program at CSUB; however, students with coursework in-progress during 3rd/4th semester may apply.

Please note: Only 70 semester units may be transferred to a California State University (CSU). An additional 20 units of CSU nursing credit may be awarded for demonstration of learning, as operationalized through passing the NCLEX RN examination. Credit earned will be determined on an individual basis and may be granted upon full admission to the CSUB campus and the RN to BSN Program. Additional documents may be required. The ADN does not guarantee admission to the RN to BSN Program at CSUB. All applicants must show evidence of meeting the minimum eligibility requirements with the submission of the RN to BSN Program application.

BSN degree total: 120 semester units (70 Transfer + 27 BSN + 3 UDGEC + 20 NCLEX Test Credits)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What are the admission requirements for the CSUB RN to BSN Program?

Do I have to drive to CSU Bakersfield?

Students generally will only need to come to campus for the on-campus Nursing Orientation, Spring Clinical Orientation, to possibly take courses satisfying Upper-Division, and to take the GWAR exam (online course may be an alternative to this option).

What is the mode of instruction for this program?

All Nursing lecture courses are online. You will need a computer with internet access to participate in each course. Additionally, students must complete 135 of on-site clinical hours in the program. Clinical placements will only be available in Kern County and Antelope Valley, unless specific arrangements are made through faculty. These hours are typically done one day per week for 16 weeks.

How much does the program cost?

The RN to BSN Program is a 15-month, full-time program that admits once per year. Tuition for the year is approximately \$13,913. Additional costs of approximately \$1,100 include but are not limited to textbooks, clinical documentation requirement fees, drug screen, background check, the nursing program evaluation fee, the University application fee, and graduation application processing. Tuition, fees, and all additional program costs are subject to change.

How do I get started?

- Take necessary Prerequisites and CSU General Education Transfer requirements at <u>College of the Sequoias</u>. Work closely with your Counselor to complete all RN Program major requirements, ADN and General Education Requirements, and CSU General Education Breadth Transfer Requirements.
- Contact the RN to BSN Advisor, for a pre-application evaluation one semester prior to applying to the RN to BSN Program to ensure completion of all requirements. This step is optional, but highly recommended.
- 3. <u>Apply to CSU Bakersfield</u> for the Fall term through Cal State Apply. Steps to complete the Admission Application will be available through the RN- BSN Website. Send all college transcripts to CSUB Admissions.
- 4. Apply to the CSUB RN to BSN Program through Nursing CAS. Applications accepted for fall entry only. Please check the website for application dates and deadlines. Send all college transcripts to NursingCAS.



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
