Subject: Annual Regulated Equipment and Tools Report

The University Police Department at California State University, Bakersfield is committed to transparency, communication, and engagement with the campus community. In July of 2022, the Board of Trustees approved the system-wide Regulated Equipment and Tools policy. This policy was adopted and published as outlined by Assembly Bill 481 and requires every law enforcement agency in the State of California to publish certain information annually regarding specified equipment.

Of the sixteen regulated types of equipment and tools, CSUB utilizes only two pieces of equipment, the 40mm launchers and a Mobile Command Post.

Information regarding the use, policy compliance, funding, and inventory for the 2025-2026 fiscal year (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026) are outlined below:

Summary of how regulated equipment and tools were used, and the purpose of its use:

UPD did not have any cases involving the use of the 40mm launchers

UPD did not have any reportable use of the Mobile Command Post.

Results of any internal audits, any information about violations of the regulated equipment and tools policy, and any actions taken in response:

UPD did not receive any audit findings or information about violations associated with the regulated equipment and tools policy.

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Results of any complaints or concerns received in regard to regulated equipment and tools and any actions taken in response:

UPD did not receive any information on any complaints or concerns associated with regulated equipment and tools.

Annual cost and source of funds for regulated equipment and tools:

Total expenditures for the 2025/2026 fiscal year for purchases or to support training, maintenance and readiness for both pieces of equipment was less than \$1,000, which was paid from the UPD general fund. These annual costs will also be paid from the UPD general fund for the incoming year.

Current inventory of regulated equipment and tools:

UPD currently possesses 4, 40mm Launchers with 39 sponge rounds and training rounds;
One 2007 Ford Expedition as a Command and Control vehicle equipped with radios and command post equipment.

Anticipated purchases:

There are no planned purchases for new regulated tools and equipment for the 2026/2027 fiscal year.

To further our efforts towards transparency and open communications, UPD will host a community engagement event on September 25, 2026 at 2:00 in Science 3 room 105 at CSUB to discuss the information contained within this 2025-2026 Annual Regulated Tools and Equipment memorandum.
