The intent of the University Police Advisory Council (UPAC) is to support the university police with recommendations and advice for planning regarding safety concerns and related police activity on the campus. The purpose of the UPAC is to create a “best in class” university police environment by assisting the university police by providing advice on utilizing community policing strategies on issues that impact the safety and quality of life of our diverse group of students, faculty, staff, and visitors. Part time and full-time faculty members are eligible and selected by the AS Exec Committee to serve two-year staggered terms. The meetings shall be at least twice per semester, with additional meetings scheduled as requested by the UPAC Facilitator. Membership consists of the following, or their respective designee.
