



Handbook and Bylaws Summer Working Group (Summer 2026)

The Academic Senate Executive Committee proposes the creation of a Summer 2026 Working Group to review and update the University Handbook and Bylaws. The goals of this effort are to:

1. Review and update the University Handbook and Bylaws to ensure both governing documents accurately reflect: a. recent campus reorganization and restructuring, b. all approved Academic Senate resolutions, c. internal consistency.
2. Conduct a preliminary review of the Handbook to identify provisions that may warrant further consideration for consistency with CSU policy, campus practice, or the CBA.

Members will collaborate on document review, revision drafting, and final recommendations for Senate consideration. In accordance with Section III of the Senate Bylaws, any and all changes to the Handbook or Bylaws will require a second reading.
