## FACULTY HONORS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (FHAC)

The Faculty Honors and Awards Committee consists of 5 full-time tenured teaching faculty members, including Librarians if elected, elected by the General Faculty for two-year staggered terms. Faculty of each of the four Schools elect one member and an alternate from their respective schools; and 1 member and 1 alternate is elected as the At-large member and alternate by the General Faculty. If any member of the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee is nominated or applies for an award or leave reviewed by the committee, that member will be replaced by the alternate during any consideration of the candidates for that award of leave. Meets once Fall, and approximately five intense meetings in Spring. 10 hours meetings, plus 10 hours review alone. Handbook 308.
