

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE & USE COMMITTEE (IACUC)

Function: Mandated by the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) by the Animal Welfare Act for nonhuman research by the Public Health Service (PHS). IACUC consists of nine members: one (1) Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM); the CSUB Safety Officer/Hazardous Materials Coordinator; two (2) persons who are not affiliated in any way with CSUB or a member of the immediate family of a person affiliated with CSUB and who represent public community interests in the proper care and use of animals; three (3) **faculty** who are practicing scientists experienced in the use of laboratory animals for teaching and research; and two (2) **faculty** whose primary concerns are in a nonscientific area. On the **recommendation of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, in consultation with the Academic Senate Executive Committee and the AVP of Grants, Research, and Sponsored Programs (GRASP), appointments are made by the President for three-year terms.** Appointments are staggered. By mutual agreement, committee members may be appointed to additional three-year terms. In consultation with the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate and the AVP of Grants, Research, and Sponsored Programs (GRASP), the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs shall select and appoint the Chairperson of the IACUC.
