BS in Applied Studies: From Fast Track to Pilot Status

RESOLVED: that the CSU Bakersfield Academic Senate request that the Bachelor of Science in Applied Studies be approved for Pilot Status.

RATIONALE: Soon after the CSUB 11/12 Academic Senate approved the fast tracked Applied Sciences program (2011-2012 RES031), the Chancellor's office announced a moratorium on fast-track proposals presented before the Board of Trustees. At this time, the School of Business and Public Administration requests that the degree be re-proposed to the Academic Senate as a pilot program. The only distinction between the program as approved by the Senate and the change requested here is classification as a pilot program rather than a fast track program. The former status is more restrictive in terms of requirements for program permanence.

As a pilot program, the degree can be offered for up to five years. At the end of this period survival of this program is contingent upon a successful application for permanent degree status approved by the CSU Board of Trustees.
