Appeal Process Revision

Appeals Process.

- 1. New <u>General Education</u> course approval requests are <u>first</u> sent to the appropriate <u>school</u> <u>curriculum</u> committee for review<u>first</u>. <u>AfterWith</u> the approval of the school <u>curriculum</u> <u>committee</u>, the proposal is then sent to the <u>General Education Curriculum Committee</u> (GECCo) <u>for approval to be included in the general education program.</u>
- 2. The committeeGECCo reviews the request using the guidelines and criteria on record. The committeeGECCo provides a written justification of its findings. In case of rejection, (a) course revision(s) can be made based on the review and resubmitted to the committeeGECCo.
- Following an unsuccessful re-submission, a written appeal can be filed with <u>CARS-the Academic Affairs Committee</u> (AAC) of the <u>CSUB Academic Senate</u> that outlines how the petitioner believes the <u>committeeGECCo</u> misinterpreted or otherwise violated its guidelines and procedures on record.
- 4. CARS AAC will verify that all rules and procedures identified by the respective committee were followed in the course of the review. CARS AAC will, if necessary, conduct oral interviews and request further information from the committee.
- 5. If the <u>CARS-AAC</u> review finds that the guidelines and procedures on record were applied correctly, the appeal is rejected.
- 6. If the <u>CARS-AAC</u> review finds that the guidelines and procedures on record were applied inappropriately, <u>the committeeGECCo</u> will be advised to reconsider. If <u>the committeeGECCo</u> cannot resolve the issues raised by <u>CARS-AAC</u>, then <u>CARS-AAC</u> will make a final decision.

NOTE: <u>CARS AAC</u> only reviews whether procedures were followed. It does not review guidelines, criterion or courses.
