EC

RESOLVED: that the Academic Senate notify the CSU Board of Trustees of CSUB's strong commitment to shared governance process and our objection to Executive Orders whose development violates principles of shared governance.

RATIONALE: According to The Higher Education Employer-Employee Relations Act, "The Legislature recognizes that joint decisionmaking [sic] and consultation between administration and faculty or academic employees is the long-accepted manner of governing institutions of higher learning and is essential to the performance of the educational missions of these institutions, and declares that it is the purpose of this chapter to both preserve and encourage that process." Recent actions by the Chancellor suggest that faculty need to remind the Chancellor of our commitment to upholding this law.
