1. Call to Order

A. Hegde called the meeting to order. He read a statement acknowledging CSUB's stewardship of the land of the Tejon Tribe.

2. Approval of Minutes

B. Street moved to approve the Minutes of April 29, 2020. C. Lam seconded. All approved.

3. Announcements and Information

- Session One - Outgoing Senate business. There are two items on the Consent Agenda.
- Session Two - Incoming Senate introduction, schedule, and Standing Committee Chair Selection.
- President's Report – L. Zelezny
 - Repopulation Plan – Thank you to all who attended the Repopulation Forum. Work continues alongside the collective bargaining units to address ideas and concerns. A website with FAQs coming.
 - Board of Trustees (BOT) meeting is May 17, May 18. An announcement of the new Presidents of CSU Channel Islands and CSU Fresno is expected.
 - Commencement Spring 2021 - CSUB is graduating 2,700 students. She thanked faculty for educating them. The President's Honors Medalist selection of Undergraduate and Graduate was a challenge. All the candidates are amazing performers.
 - Thank you to Senators for an extraordinary year of leadership. The President is honored to served alongside faculty. Congratulations to those Senators who get a break from the committee. She welcomed the new Senators.
 - Summer break – Enjoy and reenergize. She hopes that summer produces research productivity.

- OSSR Follow-up – A. Hegde prefaced the AVP Student Affairs and Dean of Student’s presentation by referring to concerns about academic integrity expressed at the Academic Senate meetings (February 18, March 4) and Executive Committee meetings (January 24, March 16) and in conversations he had with him. J. Drnek is here to provide solutions to faculty’s concerns. J. Drnek has observed that discussions on academic integrity between Student Affairs (SA) and Academic Affairs (AA) is not unusual on campuses. He is responsible for overseeing the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities (OSRR). They are charged with academic integrity programs and student conduct. As CSUB grows, there is agreement with VP SA, T. Wallace, that there is a need to increase staffing. The OSRR goals and Academic Integrity Task Force recommendations were presented, as found in the attached slide deck. Question: J. Tarjan referred to slide #8 regarding the sharing of information with faculty within FERPA regulations. Program Directors and Chairs have access to all kinds of information. There are concerns that when a student is eliminated from a course, the OSRR and others who have that type of information be encouraged to expand the sharing to include Chairs and Program Directors so they can make decisions regarding a student’s continuation of program(s) and act upon that. Response: J. Drnek will look more closely at faculty’s need to know that type of information and work with General Counsel to make sure there wouldn’t be any violation of students’ rights by sharing that information. J. Tarjan added that he and most advisors have access to students’ personal information. To say that this is a special category of information, many faculty don’t understand why that would be the case, especially when they are in a position of being held in charge of the academic integrity of programs. C. Collom noted that the Senate clearly recommended that the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities (OSRR) move to Academic Affairs. What is the resistance to that recommendation? Response: OSRR is housed in Student Affairs (SA) with other behavior programs. It seems to be a good fit due to the educational nature of it. There are staff members and they’re doing a great job. He’s using the same model used at other universities. He’s not against moving it to AA. If some of the goals shared today are introduced, there could be a great working relationship with AA. If it’s not part of SA, it makes it more difficult to partnership with AA. A. Hegde thanked J. Drnek and requested that he update the Senate in the Fall with more concrete solutions and share what he’s learned over the summer about how the Maxient software program works to identify academic violations.

8. Resolutions

a. Consent Agenda

RES 202128 Commencement Spring 2021 – Unanimously approved.

RES 202129 Commendation of Chief Williamson and Erika Delamar – A. Hegde introduced the resolution. CSUB had to change a lot of things and react quickly to the COVID-19 pandemic. Overseeing it all was Campus Police Chief M. Williamson and Director of Health Services Erika Delamar. The two individuals really stood out from the Campus Preparedness Council and Emergency Operations. As is our tradition, the Academic Senate presents commendation on behalf of faculty in appreciation for extraordinary service. It will be announced to the CSUB Family and the Board of Trustees. The Chief responded that it's been an honor to serve CSUB and it's humbling to be recognized. He thanked the many subject matter experts he worked with and campus leadership. E. Delamar noted that there are a lot of people on campus who were instrumental, such as D. Boschini, who helped them get this done. She looks forward to seeing people on campus. The resolution was approved unanimously.

b. Old Business

RES 202125 Submission of Electronic RTP for the Academic Year 2021-2021 – M. Rees stated that there were no changes from the First Reading. This resolution gives faculty the option of submitting their RTP electronically. As an aside, a survey will be going out to gather information on the pitfalls in Box. The results of the survey will be used to fix areas of Box this summer and then have an open forum in Fall on what's been done. No discussion occurred. B. Street moved to approve. Approved unanimously.

RES 202126 Resolutions During Predominately Virtual Instruction – A. Hegde reminded the group that this resolution reaffirms four resolutions approved last year. M. Danforth noted the items can

continue while under virtual instruction. It suspends the need to do Quality Matters (QM) training for asynchronous and synchronous online instruction. It allows GVAR testing to be done online, virtual classroom observations, and virtual office hours. Faculty can choose whether to have office hours in person. No discussion occurred. A. Hegde called for a vote. Approved unanimously. RES 202127 Course Repetition Policy and Process – R. Gearhart presented on behalf of AAC and AS&SS. There were no changes from the First Reading. There is a practice for students repeating a class after the third attempt. Not all departments allow students to take a class beyond the third attempt. The practice is not representative of the entire campus. This policy formalizes a previously informal process. Students must get a signature from the student's Faculty/Staff Advisor and the Program / Department Chair of the Program that is offering the course. No discussion occurred. A. Hegde called for a vote. Approved.

9. Open Forum Items

Topic: Thank you to the 2020-2021 Senators and all attendees. A. Hegde acknowledged that it's been a long year. Much was accomplished. He appreciates the Senators working through the issues and the amount of work done. It was a phenomenal year, hopefully not to be repeated in 50 years. We got closer to making it a better experience for our students and upholding our standards. He acknowledged that there were professional and personal struggles that everyone experienced. We also need to acknowledge that some of us needed more support than others. That's okay. Hopefully, this summer will be an opportunity to recharge, and we can get together in person in Fall. A. Hegde gave special thanks to the outgoing Senators and special welcome to returning and new Senators via rolling slides of their photos.
