 - 1. Numerous CSU presidential retirements.
 - 2. CSU Chancellor's Search will begin in Spring 2023 with the expectation that a new chancellor will be named in July 2023.
 - 3. The Quantitative Reasoning requirement that was proposed will not be going forward.
 - 4. Cozen O'Connor Visit: They are prioritizing the CSU campuses that are being audited, such as Fresno State University. CSUB is

- not one of the campuses being audited. At the end of their work, each campus is expected to receive their own separate reports. Anticipates receiving the report for CSUB at the end of the Spring 2023 semester.
- 5. RES 222305 GWAR Requirement Update: Presented the Academic Senate's resolution to Executive Vice Chancellor Sylvia Alva and Allison Brand. They discussed the resolution and CSUB's Academic Senate's dissatisfaction with the consultation process. She requested a one-year exemption for CSUB, which was denied. They proposed requesting a GWAR waiver for high unit majors as a possible option.
