Its recommendations for new programs and modifications to extent ones are reviewed by the Academic Senate and approved by the President before submission to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Faculty is **appointed by the Senate Executive Committee** to serve two-year staggered terms **upon recommendation by the Vice President of Academic Affairs. Handbook 201.5**
