Obtain an Added Authorization in Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE-AA)

Who is eligible to obtain ECSE-AA?

- ✓ A valid Education Specialist Preliminary or Clear Credential Holder.
- ✓ Teacher candidates in an accredited Education Specialist Credential program.

When does the program begin?

- ✓ Classes begin Fall semester, 2022.
- ✓ A waiver or substitution of courses may be possible.
- ✓ Can complete the program within 2 semesters.
