The Multiple Subject Credential Program is a professional preparation program accredited by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) and Association for Advancing Educator Preparation (AAQEP).

Our program prepares candidates to teach multiple subjects in a self-contained classroom such as those in most elementary schools. Our teacher candidates are provided the tools to create diverse, inclusive, and equitable classrooms with an integrated approach to theory and practice. Our program is primarily a face-to-face program with courses beginning in the early evenings.

### **Getting Started**

- 1. Apply to the university
- 2. Enroll in prerequisites
- 3. Apply to the program

#### Step 1 – Apply to university

Apply as a graduate student at: <u>calstate.edu/apply/graduate</u> Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree
- 2.5 GPA or higher required
- Good academic standing from previous university
- Meet professional, personal, scholastic, and other standards for graduate study
   Send your transcripts within 30 days & by deadline

#### **Step 2** – Enroll in prerequisites

Upon receiving university admission, you may register for the prerequisite courses which can be found under Teacher Prep in the class search EDTE 3000 – Introduction to education EDTE 3308 – Sociocultural foundations in education EDTE 4100 – Teaching English learners & special populations EDTE 4200 – Technology for educators

#### Step 3 – Apply to the program

Applicants should prepare to apply to the program during their prerequisites. Current program deadlines and full instructions are listed at <u>Application and Admission Guidelines</u>. For applicant checklist, please see reverse.

To be considered for program admission the following requirements must be met. Priority admission consideration is given to applicants meeting 100% of the requirements. Meeting the requirements does not guarantee program admission. For an electronic version, scan QR code.

- □ Hold a bachelor's degree
- Attend an information session: Information Sessions

  - Pay \$70.00 nonrefundable application fee
  - GPA of 2.5 or higher required
  - Send one official transcript from every college/university attended. Electronic delivery recommended

- Apply to the credential program
  - GPA of 2.75 or higher required
  - Submit a complete application by the program deadline

- Applicants will be notified by email regarding their application. If admitted to the credential program, you will receive an admission letter with further instructions and requirements to complete your program.
