



### Granting Credit by Exam

Students have the option of satisfying course requirements by examination. You can process test credit in a manner similar to transfer course credit. You can articulate the test credit to any term in which the student is active (that is, the student has a valid term activation) and can associate the test credit with any active class in the course catalog. These instructions will guide you through this process.

1. Navigate to the **Records and Enrollment > Transfer Credit Evaluation > Test Credits - Manual**

2. If the student has test credit of any kind, search for an existing record. On the **Find an Existing Value** page, enter the credit by exam data and click **Search**.

If you receive the message, "no matching values found" click the Add a New Value tab. On the Add a New Value page, enter the following information:

- In ID, enter the student's CSUB ID
- In Academic Career, select the academic career.
- In Academic Institution, enter BKCOMP
- Click the **Add**.

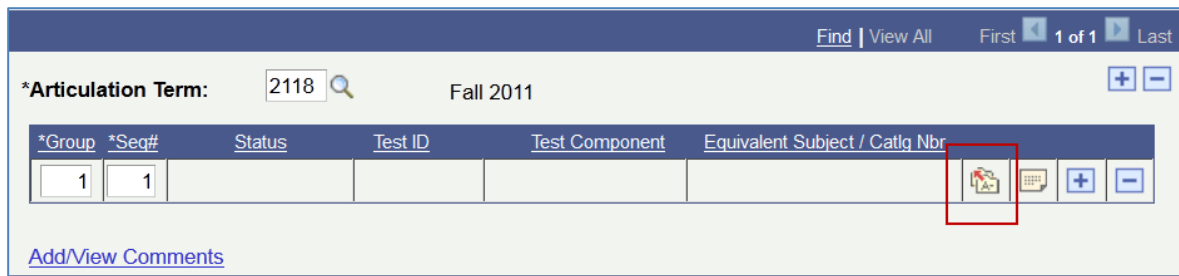

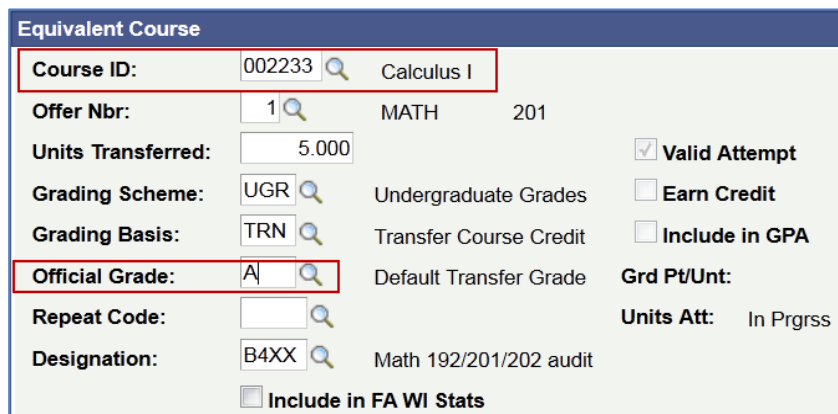
