BAS HOLIDAY BREAKFAST 2022

On December 6th, Jamie Pacheco, the Veteran Success Center Coordinator, and Andrew Alba, a Veteran Student Assistant, each gave speeches at the Business & Administrative Services Holiday Breakfast. They thanked BAS for their support for the Veteran Success Center.

There were an estimated 500 people in attendance. In her speech, Jamie imparted to them that their contributions support 744 military-connected students, including 230 veterans who were enrolled for Fall 2022. The Center also had 852 student sign-ins for the fall semester alone.

Alba relayed to the attendees that the Veteran Success Center helped his transition into the university. He spoke about how the camaraderie, the friendships he has made, and the support from everyone at the Center have positively impacted him. This is a place where he can be himself.

After the speeches, CSUB Police Chief Marty Williamson presented Jamie and Andrew with a donation of \$2000 on behalf of BAS.
