Veterans with immunization holds

IF YOU ARE A CHAPTER 33 POST 9/11 GI BILL STUDENT, AND IF YOU HAVE AN IMMUNIZATION HOLD, READ BELOW:

Veterans can come to the Health Center on **Wednesday, March 23rd from 8:30 to 11:30 AM and 1:00 to 4:30 PM** for assistance with their immunization holds.

They will need to bring their DD-214, a recent TB test (administered within one year of entering CSUB), their ID and a mask.

- If they do not have a recent TB test, we will provide one for them that day.
- Everyone who receives a TB test with us will need to be available to come back to the Health Center around the same time on **Friday, March 25th**.

Before coming to the Health Center, they will need to complete the COVID pre-screening (same day).

- When they arrive at the front entrance to the Health Center, they will need to call **661-477-3114** to get checked in.
- If they have their DD-214 and a recent TB test, their holds will be cleared the same day.
- If they need to get the TB test with the Health Center, their holds will be cleared by **Tuesday, March 29th**.

Be sure to check your myCSUB for any advising or immunization holds. If you have any, please finish them by the deadline provided in your myCSUB hold listings.

If you have an advisor hold, check your myCSUB account and see the name and number for your academic advisor.
