



Four-Year Degree Pledge

In-coming freshman or a second-semester freshman student who is committed to graduating in four years through the California Promise Degree Four-Year Pledge Program must meet the following conditions:

- Participate in a New Student Orientation (Runner Rundown) at entrance to the university.
- Attend a California Promise (CAP) Informational Session provided by your designated CAP pledge adviser, to approve your academic degree completion plan.
- Student is responsible to schedule one appointment per semester with their CAP pledge adviser to review courses and degree planning prior to class registration (refer to the Academic Calendar for term registration dates).
- Place in college level Math and English classes appropriate to the major.
- Enrollment in at least 15 units per semester, or complete at least 30 units each academic year including summer and winter intersession, as required to complete your bachelor's degree.
- Maintain "good academic standing" which means to earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 each semester.
- Maintain course pattern as related to the degree completion plan provided by your CAP pledge adviser.
- Remain in the same major through the duration of your degree pledge program when admitted.
- Check your student CSUB email account and the CAP website on a regular basis, for program updates and announcements.
- Be a California resident for purpose of in-state tuition eligibility.
- Complete at least 30 units each year including summer and winter intersession.
- Attend student orientation sessions at entrance to the University.
- Maintain course pattern as related to the degree completion plan.
- Enroll in required course at those times when they are offered and/or available (which may include evening and weekend hours).
- Remain in the same major they selected when they entered the University
- Check student CSUB email account and the Pledge Website on a regular basis.
